- Copy of Grade 12 Statement of results or latest report.
- Copy of Senior Certificate or Statement of symbols with admission to a bachelor's degree or diploma, with at least level 5 in English and level 4 in Mathematics, level 4 Physical Science/Accountancy and two (2) other content subjects including Life Orientation.
- Certified copies of salary advice of parent/s or guardian and affidavit indicating employment status of the parents/guardian.
- Certified copies of identity documents of both applicant and parents/guardian.
- Copy of University, University of Technology and FET College admission letter for 2021 academic year.

- ◆ Town Planning, Human Settlements, Land use management, Agriculture and Forestry.
