- 1. The municipality will advertise residential sites for sale in the local media and through the notice boards at all municipal offices in line with Section 79(18) of the Local Government Ordinance, 1939 (ordinance 17 of 1939), as amended and read together with Section 21 of the Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000 as amended and Section 14(2) of the Municipal Finance Management Act 56 of 2003 regarding the disposal of municipal owned erven.
- 2. The list containing the description of the residential sites for sale together with the price list will be made available at municipal offices for public access.
- 3. Application forms will be issued to those interested to apply.
- 4. An official correspondence will be issued informing the applicant on the outcome of their application and give further instructions to be followed.

The public is urged to report those involved in these criminal activities to the police to bring those responsible to book.
